III. Old Business

A. Federal Actions

- --Starting July 1, the major U.S. tobacco companies had to begin to post <u>signs</u> telling the public the truth about the deadly consequences of cigarette smoking at about 220,000 retail stores.
- -- On August 23, FDA issued <u>warning letters</u> to 15 online retailers for selling and/or distributing unauthorized e-cigarette products packaged to look like youth-appealing characters, school supplies, toys, and drinks.

B. Kentucky/Synar

- --Kentucky's new annual directory of approved cigarettes/RYO was posted July 1, 2023.
- --591 Synar inspections were done for 2023. Compliance rate over 90%

IV. New Business

- **1.** CDC Report: Monitoring E-cigarette Use Among Youth, June 2023: E-cig sales rose 44% from 2020-2023.
- **2.** Truth Report: Industry Influencer-How Tobacco Content Infiltrates Social Media: Social media has misinformation about tobacco products and youth advertising.
