Minutes

I. CALL TO ORDER

- a. The Reform and Compliance Subcommittee convened with two members attending one member absent. Those members in attendance were Lorran Ferguson (in person representing Allison Ball) and Vic Brown (remote). Representative Danny Bentley was absent.

II. NEW BUSINESS

- a. Opening Comments & Naming of the Chair.

Mr. Brown motioned to make Mr. Bentley the chair of the subcommittee. Ms. Ferguson seconded. The motion to name Mr. Bentley the chair of the subcommittee was unanimous.

- b. The subcommittee began the meeting with introductions, including introductions of public participants.
- c. The subcommittee discussed the proposed disclosure forms and draft regulations.
- d. The subcommittee made edits to the proposed disclosure forms and draft regulations, which were submitted to Alison Chavies.
 - i. The subcommittee's edits sought to draw a balance between information essential to Commission determinations and the deterrent effect that comes with seeking too much information from applicants.
 - ii. Proposed edits included input from public participants who provided insight into the manner in which grant applications could be evaluated based on their previous experience, the kind of applicants who might apply and the level/type of information that may discourage applications.
