Affiant, Holly Proffit, states that she is a Social Worker with the Cabinet for Health and Family Services and that as such, she and her supervisor, received a report that the minor children of parents Audrey Thomas and Chris Arnold had not been attending school for the past 2 weeks. Said social workers then undertook to locate said children. Affiant states that this led she and Ms. Ruble to learn that Audrey Thomas had been residing with Chris Arnold at the address listed above. Further, Affiant states that there is currently a DVO in place which prohibits contact between Mr. Arnold and Ms. Thomas. Said order is contained in Kenton County case 12-D-359-001 and prohibits Mr. Arnold from having any contact or communication with Ms. Thomas. Affiant states that further Judge Christopher Mehling has a standing order in the above child's dependency, abuse or neglect case which also prohibits Ms. Thomas and Mr. Arnold from having contact with one another. Affiant states that she went to the address listed above and can clearly hear a television inside, that there are lights on in the home and that the Ms. Thomas' car is parked outside. Affiant further states that the neighbor has indicated that Chris and Audrey live in the apartment together. Affiant believes that the parties are present within the home despite the fact that they will not answer the door for her or Covington PD. Affiant states that a collateral source has indicated that Ms. Thomas has texted her while the Affiant is outside the home and indicated that she was going to jail.

This further makes Affiant believe that Ms. Thomas and Mr. Arnold are in the home with the child despite Court orders.
